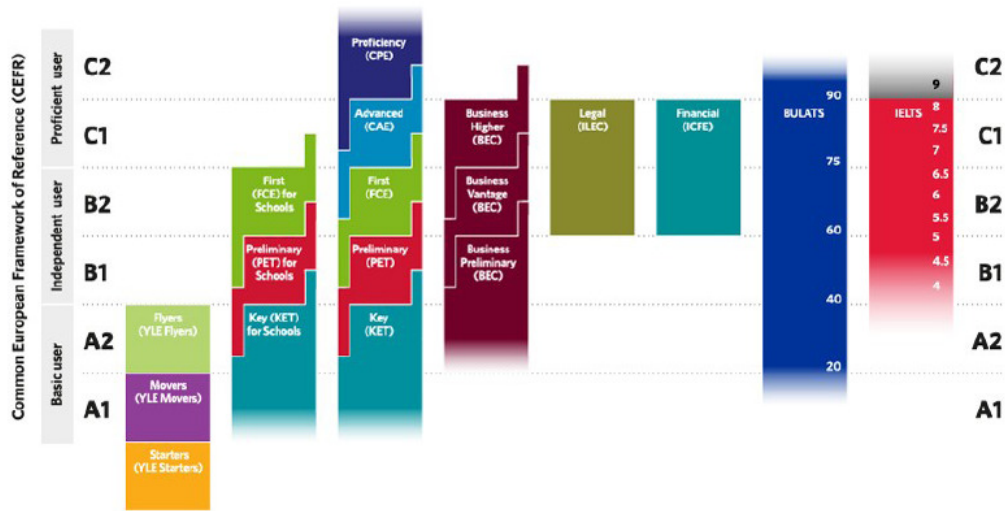

It has become accepted as a way of benchmarking language ability not only within Europe but worldwide and plays a central role in language and education policy.
